PLAN.LAVOTE.GOV has everything you need for the November 8th General Election.

The LA County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk is the official source for accurate and unbiased election information and voting resources. It has never been faster or easier to be a voter! Learn how you can prepare for the election and make your voice heard. Make your plan to vote today.



How can I register to vote? When is the registration deadline to receive a Vote By Mail ballot?

If you've moved, are new to LA County, or are voting for the very first time, you **must** register to vote by October 24, 2022 to receive a Vote by Mail ballot. The easiest way to register to vote is to visit **PLAN.LAVOTE.GOV**. Paper voter registration cards are also available at most government buildings – like libraries, post offices, or DMV offices. If you miss the deadline, you can still register in-person at any Vote Center when you come to cast your ballot.

Can I track my Vote by Mail Ballot?

Yes! You can track your ballot every step of the way, for free, by subscribing to *Where's My Ballot?* (<u>california.ballottrax.net</u>). You will receive notifications on the status of your ballot by email or text message. After you return your ballot, you will be notified when it is received at the Registrar's office so that you know it is being counted.

What are my voting options?

- Vote by mail and vote early. Skip the lines and save time! Every registered voter in LA County will be mailed a ballot for the General Election starting October 6th. All you have to do is fill it out, sign the Return Envelope, and send it back as soon as you receive it.
- 2. **Drop off at a Ballot Drop Box.** Vote early with no waiting. It only takes a few moments to return your ballot at one of 400 Official Ballot Drop Box locations. The Vote by Mail packet includes a list of convenient locations near you.
- 3. Visit any Vote Center beginning Oct. 29. You're never far from a convenient place to vote in-person. LA County voters can cast their ballot at any Vote Center. Find a Vote Center near you at PLAN.LAVOTE.GOV, and make your plan to vote before Election Day.

Save time at the Vote Center by filling out your Poll Pass! Use this quick, easy and secure online tool to speed up in-person voting by making your selections before you leave the house. A separate mailing will be sent to every registered voter showing the nearest Vote Center locations.
