

# Register to Vote!

It only takes 5 minutes to make sure your voice is heard.

The Los Angeles County Registrar-Recorder/County Clerk (RR/CC) has everything you need to cast your ballot in the **upcoming Statewide Primary Election!** Registering to vote is quick, easy, and you can do it online.

Learn how you can prepare for the election and make your voting plan.

## How can I register to vote?

If you've moved recently, are voting for the first time, or are new to L.A. County you must register to vote by **May 18th, 2026** to receive a Vote by Mail ballot.

The simplest way to register to vote is to visit [PLAN.LAVOTE.GOV](https://plan.lavote.gov).

If you miss the deadline, you can still register at any Vote Center when you go to cast your ballot.

# What are my voting options?

You have the following flexible, convenient options to cast your ballot:



## 1. Drop off at a Ballot Drop Box beginning April 30th.

Save your time and skip the lines! You can return your ballot at one of 400+ official Ballot Drop Box locations across L.A. County. Find a Ballot Drop Box near you at [PLAN.LAVOTE.GOV](https://plan.lavote.gov).



## 2. Vote by Mail.

Ballots are mailed to every registered voter in L.A. County starting April 30th. Just fill it out, sign the Return Envelope, and send it back ASAP – at least 7 days before Election Day.



## 3. Visit any Vote Center beginning May 23rd.

L.A. County voters can cast their ballot at any Vote Center. Find one near you at [PLAN.LAVOTE.GOV](https://plan.lavote.gov) and make your voting plan before Election Day!
